YORK COUNTY HISTORY CENTER IS A 2023 BLUE STAR MUSEUM

History Center museums to offer free admission to military personnel and their families this summer

YORK, PA. – MAY 16, 2023 – The York County History Center announced it will join museums nationwide in the Blue Star Museums initiative, a program that provides free admission to currently-serving U.S. military personnel and their families this summer. The 2023 program will begin on Armed Forces Day, Saturday, May 20, and end on Labor Day, Monday, Sept. 4. Find the list of participating museums at arts.gov/bluestarmuseums.

Blue Star Museums is a partnership between the National Endowment for the Arts and Blue Star Families, in collaboration with the Department of Defense and participating museums across America.

"The men and women currently serving in our armed forces are following in the footsteps of generations of servicemen and servicewomen," said Joan Mummert, president and CEO of the History Center. "The stories of their lives are an important part of what we house here at the History Center, from the documents and records in our Library & Archives to the many uniforms, flags and other military artifacts in our Collections. We're honored to be able to offer our resources for free through the Blue Star program, and we're grateful to NEA, Blue Star Families and the Department of Defense for making the program available."

"We thank the 2023 Blue Star Museums who invite military personnel and their families to experience the many wonders they have to offer, whether it's a glimpse into the past, an encounter with aweinspiring art, or a moment of discovery," said Maria Rosario Jackson, PhD, chair of the National Endowment for the Arts. "The York County History Center is helping to enrich the lives of military families and build meaningful connections between our nation's military and their local community."

Blue Star Museums include children's museums, art, science, and history museums, zoos, gardens, lighthouses, and more, and hail from all 50 states, District of Columbia, and the U.S. Virgin Islands. The <u>current list of participating museums</u> will continue to develop over the summer as organizations are welcome to <u>register to be a Blue Star Museum</u> throughout the summer.

The free admission program is available for those currently serving in the United States Military—Air Force, Army, Coast Guard, Marine Corps, Navy, and Space Force, members of the Reserves, National Guard, U.S. Public Health Commissioned Corps, NOAA Commissioned Corps, and up to five family members. Qualified members must show a **Geneva Convention common access card** (CAC), **DD Form**



1173 ID card (dependent ID), DD Form 1173-1 ID card or the Next Generation Uniformed Services (Real) ID card for entrance into a participating Blue Star Museum.
