VISIT PENNSYLVANIA'S HISTORY CORRIDOR

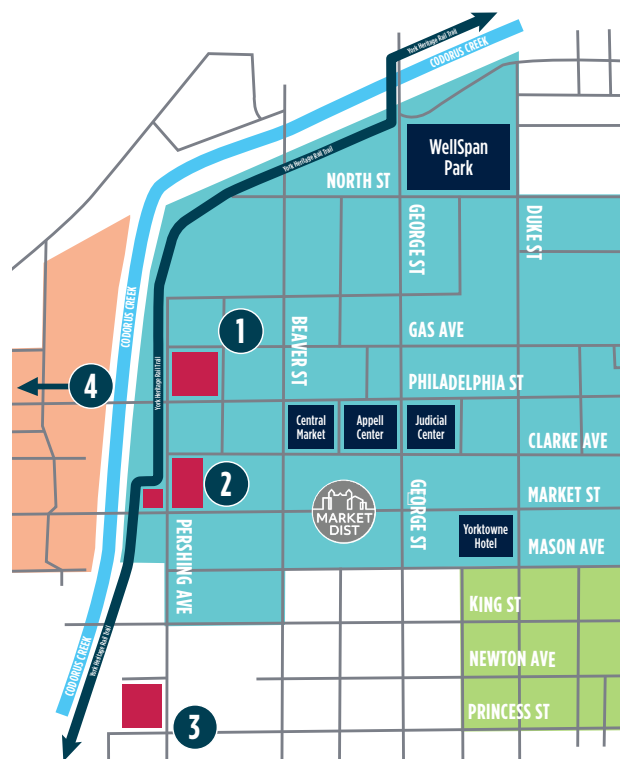
The York County History Center is located in the middle of some of the Mid-Atlantic's most popular history and visitor destinations.
