### **BIOGRAPHY OF IOSIAH WILLIAM GITT**

Josiah William Gitt was born in Hanover, Pennsylvania on March 28, 1884. He was also known as J.W. Gitt and Jess Gitt. He was the son of Clinton Jacob Gitt, who worked at the family store, and Emma Belle Koplin. He studied at Franklin and Marshall College in Lancaster, Pennsylvania, and graduated in 1904. Gitt then studied law at the University of Pennsylvania. In 1909, he became a court reporter for The York Gazette, which was owned by his uncle. In 1913, he married Elizabeth Glatfelter Moul, and they had four children.

In 1915, Gitt and his partner, Allen C. Wiest, purchased The York Gazette newspaper, and later purchased The York Daily newspaper in 1918. Gitt and Wiest merged the two newspapers, creating The Gazette and Daily. Under Gitt, the newspaper gained a national reputation for its independent news orientation and editorial positions. Gitt and The Gazette and Daily gained world-wide attention in 1948 when the newspaper backed Henry Wallace for President. The Gazette and Daily was the only U.S. newspaper to endorse Wallace. Gitt and his newspaper joined Progressives and others who questioned the Cold War, McCarthyism, and the Vietnam War. He was a supporter of the Civil Rights Movement. Due to his political views, Gitt was investigated by the FBI on suspicion that he was a communist. For over fifty years, Gitt published The Gazette and Daily, directing its content, selecting its news items, and editorializing. Gitt sold the newspaper in 1970, when The Gazette and Daily was renamed the York Daily Record. Gitt died on October 7, 1973 in Boston, Massachusetts.

#### SCOPE AND CONTENTS OF THE COLLECTION

The collection contains letters, magazine articles and newspaper clippings from J.W. Gitt's personal papers that he accumulated during his time as the owner of The Gazette and Daily. The collection includes non-political letters from 1947 to 1970, political letters from 1943 to the 1960s, items from Gitt's congressional campaign, newspaper articles about J.W. Gitt and The Gazette and Daily, articles about various political figures, editorials from The Gazette and Daily, letters about the sale of The Gazette and Daily, the FBI files on J.W. Gitt, business records for The Gazette and Daily, and a scrapbook compiled by Gitt's wife. The collection also contains eight boxes of research material compiled by Mary A. Hamilton for her book about Gitt, *Rising From The Wilderness*, including cassette tapes of research notes.

## ORGANIZATION OF THE COLLECTION

Gitt's personal papers came to the York County Heritage Trust primarily as they had been organized by Gitt. Gitt's organizational structure was largely maintained, however similar items were grouped together by topic and by date.
